Local transportation

From Amsterdam Schipol Airport - frequent train service to Rotterdam Centraal

From Rotterdam Centraal train station: Taxi or Metro & bus/shuttle bus

Take Metro line D or E in the direction of Slinge or De Akkers. Get off the train at Rijnhaven station.

From Rijnhaven, take bus 77 to S.S. Rotterdam.

From the 77 line bus stop "ss Rotterdam" it is a 5 minute walk to the main entrance of the ship and its hotel.
