It looks like the International Dystonia Symposium, scheduled to be held alongside the D-DAYS 2020 in Dublin, will be postponed as well.


The health and safety of all our members, patients and families, the speakers and health professionals, and all others involved in the event, is extremely important to us.

We will share more information later on the dates of the D-DAYS 2021.


